

## Registrations to the Building Safety Fund

The figure for total registration has increased by 36 from the statistics published on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020. This reflects 35 registrations for buildings identified with ACM and non-ACM cladding that applied via the Private Sector ACM Cladding Remediation Fund and one additional registration. There are currently 59 registrations for buildings with both ACM and non-ACM cladding systems.
